The children in **Nursery** will be looking at growth and change. They will have the opportunity to watch the life cycle of a caterpillar first hand. The children will see the caterpillars grow, spin into cocoons and then see them emerge as butterflies. They will then release the butterflies into our outdoor area.

Alongside this, the children will be learning about our natural world through mini-beast hunts and planting/gardening activities.
